# MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



"See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?" — Isaiah 43:19

As we journeyed through the first half of 2026, we entered the year with grateful hearts and renewed hope, trusting that God continues to do a new thing in and through The Turning Point. Every woman who comes through our doors carries her own story, struggles and hopes for the future. Our calling is not simply to provide a safe place for recovery, but to journey alongside each woman towards restoration, reconciliation and a renewed life in Christ.

One area we are placing greater emphasis on this year is family strengthening. We recognise that recovery does not take place in isolation. Families can be an important source of encouragement and stability as our residents rebuild their lives. At the same time, relationships may have been strained through years of addiction, incarceration, hurt and separation. In 2026, we are therefore introducing a Family Strengthening Programme to help residents and their families rebuild communication, restore relationships and develop healthier ways of supporting one another. Our hope is that healing experienced within The Turning Point will extend beyond our residents and into their families.

We are also intentional about nurturing the spiritual growth of our residents. As a Christ-centred organisation, we believe that lasting transformation involves not only behavioural change, but also renewal of the heart, mind and spirit. We are exploring the introduction of the Alpha Programme to provide our residents with a safe and welcoming space to discover more about the Christian faith, ask questions, understand the love of God and grow in their personal relationship with Christ.



# MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Another important focus continues to be aftercare. Recovery does not end when a resident completes her residential programme. Returning to the community brings a different set of challenges, rebuilding family relationships, sustaining employment, managing responsibilities and remaining committed to a drug-free life. Our aftercare work enables us to continue walking alongside our women during this critical transition. Through regular engagement, encouragement and practical support, we hope that each woman will know that she does not have to journey alone.

As we look towards the second half of 2026, we remain thankful for our staff, Executive Committee, volunteers, churches, partners, donors and supporters who continue to believe in the work and mission of The Turning Point.

Above all, we give thanks to God, who remains at the centre of all that we do. May The Turning Point continue to be a place where women encounter hope, experience restoration and discover that, through Christ, a new beginning is always possible.

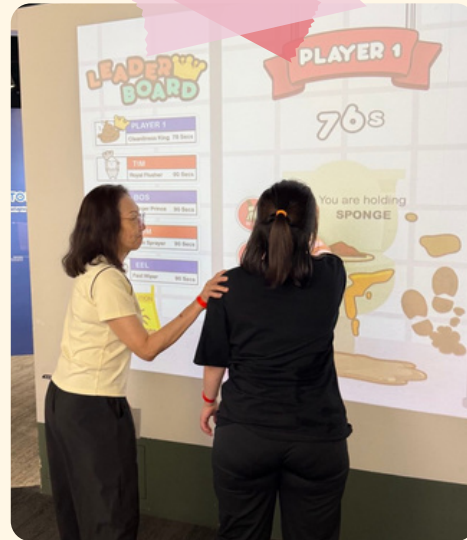

# TESTIMONY BY ALUMNI



Even when I was exhausted in TTP in 2020, I never missed counselling. I treated that time as a stepping stone and leaned into God's Word. That discipline mattered.

After finishing the programme and urine tests, I slipped. In the middle of smoking, God met me with that inner voice: "I am the righteousness of God in Christ." It was the same truth a volunteer once shared. That moment broke me open to prayer.

I asked God for three things: a nearby church, new friends, and to be a vessel. Within two weeks, God moved. I locked myself in to reset, then He sent strangers who became friends, and A Glorious Church, just five minutes from my house. Then came Autumn Community, where I served as a peer leader.

I was invited to J Club, a female care group under NCC, for its first anniversary to see old friends. J Club wasn't my plan, but it was God's plan for me. I stayed. Now I am on the worship team, helping, and I have even gone on yearly mission trips to Segamat and Tanjung Pinang.

After my relapse, my heart went out to others. I see TTP ex-residents still cycling in and out of prison and TP, and instead of judgment, I carry belief: "I believe and trust in God's timing for all these ladies."

My words for those who are still struggling in the darkness:

"Come back to God. Only God can transform the life of someone struggling with addiction. You are not alone. We are always here for you through our experiences with God."

My testimony is for counsellors and volunteers who pour out and sometimes wonder if the seeds they plant take root. It is also an inspiration for residents who are tired, still in the dark, and think they have gone too far.



# TESTIMONY BY ALUMNI

My life journey shows a few things really clearly: God hears specific prayers. Relapse is not the end of the story. God really does turn stepping stones into platforms—from TTP, to Autumn Community, to J Club, and to the mission fields.

The way I have walked it—with tears, prayer, community, and worship—is the kind of testimony that gives others permission to believe that Jesus is a God of transformation.

I have already done the hard part by living it, and so can you.

All glory to my Transformer, Jesus. Amen 🙏
